The various cleats used in this project are attached with screws and glue. Some of them have their ends rounded — check the drawings for details.

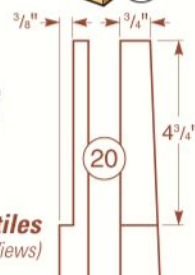
Front Divider (Side View)
